(a) UP-19-09 **Approved 7-0** PARK VIEW - Robert C. Barclay, IV, Esquire, with Cooper, Spong, and Davis, on behalf of ABS LINC VA, Inc., requests a Use Permit for an Adult Day Care Center at 230 Fort Lane, 927 Crawford Parkway, and 231 Hatton Street. The properties are zoned Historic Limited Office (HLO). The properties are designated on the Future Land Use Map in the City’s Comprehensive Plan for High Density Single-Family development as well as Institutional/Public use. (b) UP-19-10 **Approved 7-0** PORT NORFOLK - Susan Slater is requesting a Use Permit to operate a micro-brewery at 346 Broad Street. The property is owned by Port Norfolk Properties LLC (William C.
