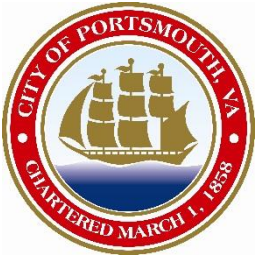

UPTOWN - Mark Dignard, of Innovate Architecture & Interiors, is requesting to rezone approximately 2 acres located at 1501, 1509, 1515, 1519, 1523, and 1541 High Street; 1502, 1538, 1540, 1544, and 1520 King Street; and 517 Peninsula Avenue from D2-Form Based Code (FBC) to Neighborhood Mixed-Use (NMU) in order to construct a 25,000 square foot Hampton Roads Community Health Center.
