48th Annual Seawall Art Show Features Artists from throughout the Eastern Seaboard

(Portsmouth, Virginia August 10, 2018) – The 48th Annual Seawall Art Show, will be held Saturday and Sunday, August 25 and 26, on High Street between Crawford and Court streets, in the Olde Towne Portsmouth Arts District. Art show hours are 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Saturday and 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Sunday. If you want to find that one-of-a-kind gift for someone special or a signature piece for yourself, then the 48th Annual Seawall Art Show is the place to be. The 2018 Seawall Art Show will be judged by Corey Piper, Ph.D., Brock Curator of American Art at the Chrysler Museum. Artists vie for more than \$7,000 in awards, including *Best of Show*. The art show is supported by the Portsmouth Museums Foundation. Proceeds from the 48th Annual Seawall Art Show support the arts in Portsmouth.

This year's art show features work by more than 75 artists from up and down the eastern seaboard. Fine art and crafts will be featured including artwork in photography, wood, sculpture, jewelry, clay, oil, acrylic, digital art, glass, watercolor, drawing, gourds, fiber and mixed media. In addition, the Seawall Art Show Student Show and Sale, takes place on opening day and features work by area public and private school students. Local performing arts professionals will provide entertainment during the show. Performances include the *Top Hats Orchestra*, *Who We Are Not*, *Jim Newsom*, *Larry Weintraub & Trio*, *Richard Spano & the Shadow Brothers*, *Charlton Phaneuf and Old School*, *New School*.

According to a mention about the Seawall Art Show in ArtFairInsiders.com, "many of the artists have done this show for years, and the incredible dedication of the volunteers is a big reason why." Thousands of art patrons attend this fine art and craft show and sale each year.

The Seawall Art Show outdoor event is held rain or shine. Admission is free and there is plenty of free parking offered on the street (outside the show area) and in public parking garages both days of the event. Olde Towne and its surroundings offer a pedestrian area conducive to browsing and walking. Participants are invited to visit the Seawall Art Show Headquarters where volunteers will be assisting patrons with show programs, Portsmouth Visitor's Guides, and additional suggestions for shopping and dining in Olde Towne.
