# WHAT IS PROJECT LIFESAVER?

---

Project Lifesaver is a rescue and recovery program established in Portsmouth in 2003. The mission of this program is to locate victims of Alzheimer's and other related conditions that may cause someone to wander away from caregivers.

By forming partnerships with local law enforcement and public safety organizations, Project Lifesaver deploys specially trained teams with current state of the art tracking technology to locate and return wandering adults or children to their families and caregivers.

Project Lifesaver is endorsed by the National Sheriff's Association, the Virginia Sheriff's Association, Hampton Road's Alzheimer's Association, International Society of Crime Prevention, Commonwealth Autism Service (Virginia) and by the National Pilot's Club.

## HOW DOES THE PROGRAM WORK?

After enrolling in the Portsmouth chapter of the Project Lifesaver program, your loved one will be equipped with a monitoring bracelet. If your loved one should become lost or wander away, you would contact the Portsmouth Police Dispatch at #911; afterwards you may call the Portsmouth Sheriff's Office at the phone number provided to you.
