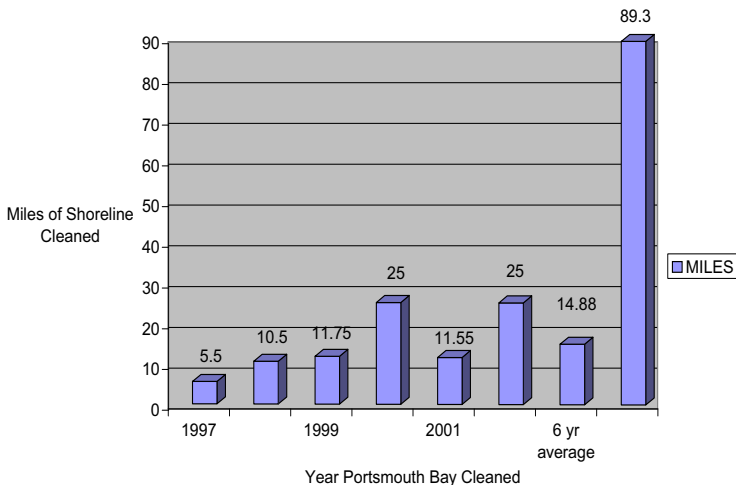
Portsmouth is Improving by a Landslide! Our Participation from 1997 to 2002

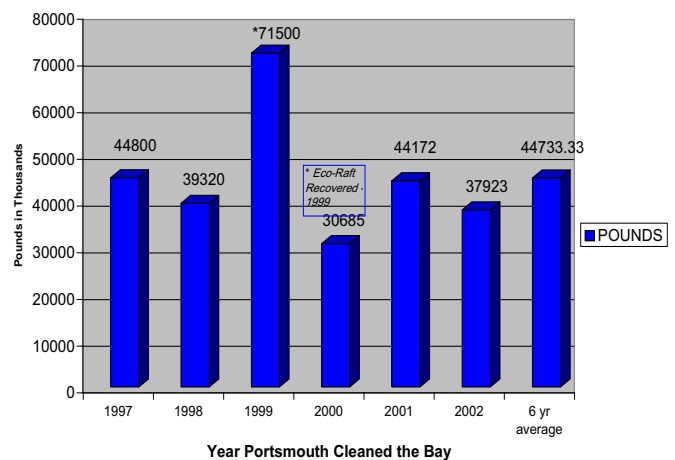
MILES OF PORTSMOUTH WATERWAYS AND BAY CLEANED
