Recognizing our Accomplishments in 2004

- **149,308** pounds bulk collected during Operation: Clean Up Portsmouth, in **11** neighborhoods, with approx. **100** volunteers.
- **26** senior or disabled homeowners ridded of **10,000** pounds of storm debris in January and March of **2004** (Operation: Guardian Shepherd) - approx. **100** volunteers.



- June **2004** - "Friends of the Community, Inc." launched to focus on fundraising



- Clean the Bay Day **2004** - **27,322** pounds of debris collected in **9** neighborhoods with **364** volunteers.

- **21** Adopt-a-Spot Clean ups held in **2004** with approximately **200** volunteers.

- Total volunteers for all projects: **764**.
- Average length of service **3** hours @ **\$17.50** per hour
- **\$40,110.00** for work if performed by paid staff!
