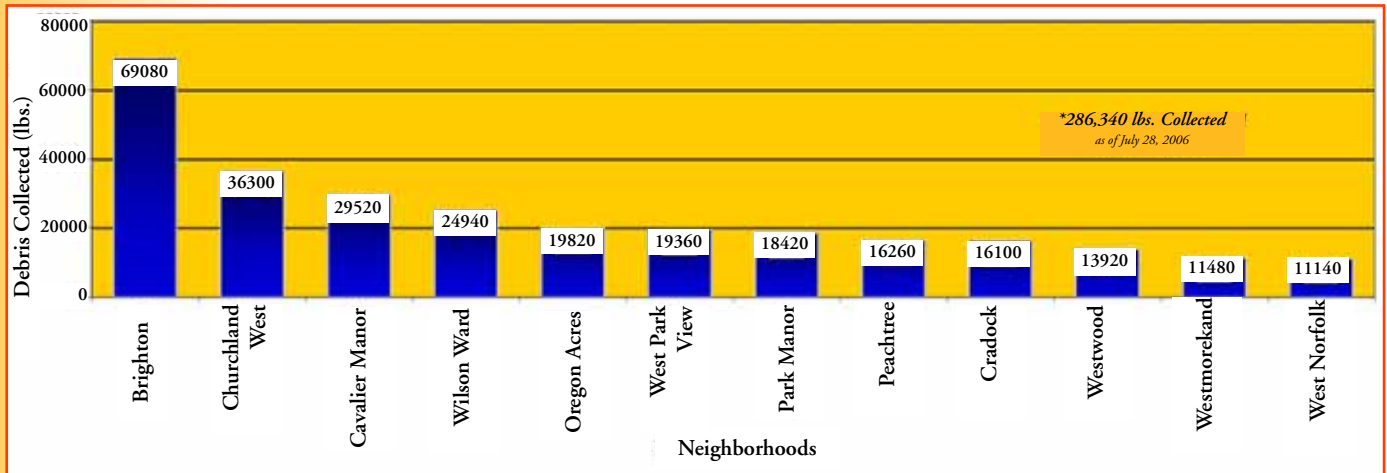

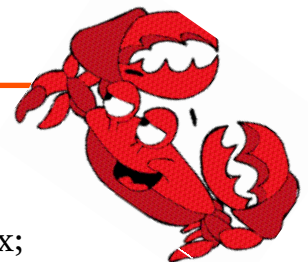

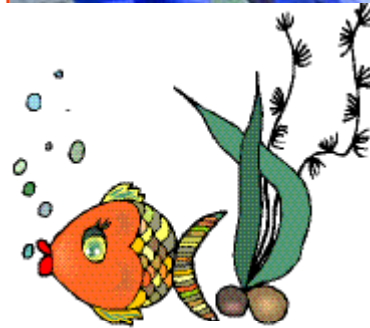

Already this year, the Clean Community Commission has hosted nineteen Community Clean Ups, welcomed ten new Adopt-A-Spot contracts and partnered with the Elizabeth River Project, and the Stormwater Division of Public Utilities/Public Works to clean-up sixteen waterways during this year's Clean the Bay Day, ridding the city of a combined total of approximately 251,298 lbs of litter and debris. However, we're not finished yet!
