Organization of the City of Portsmouth

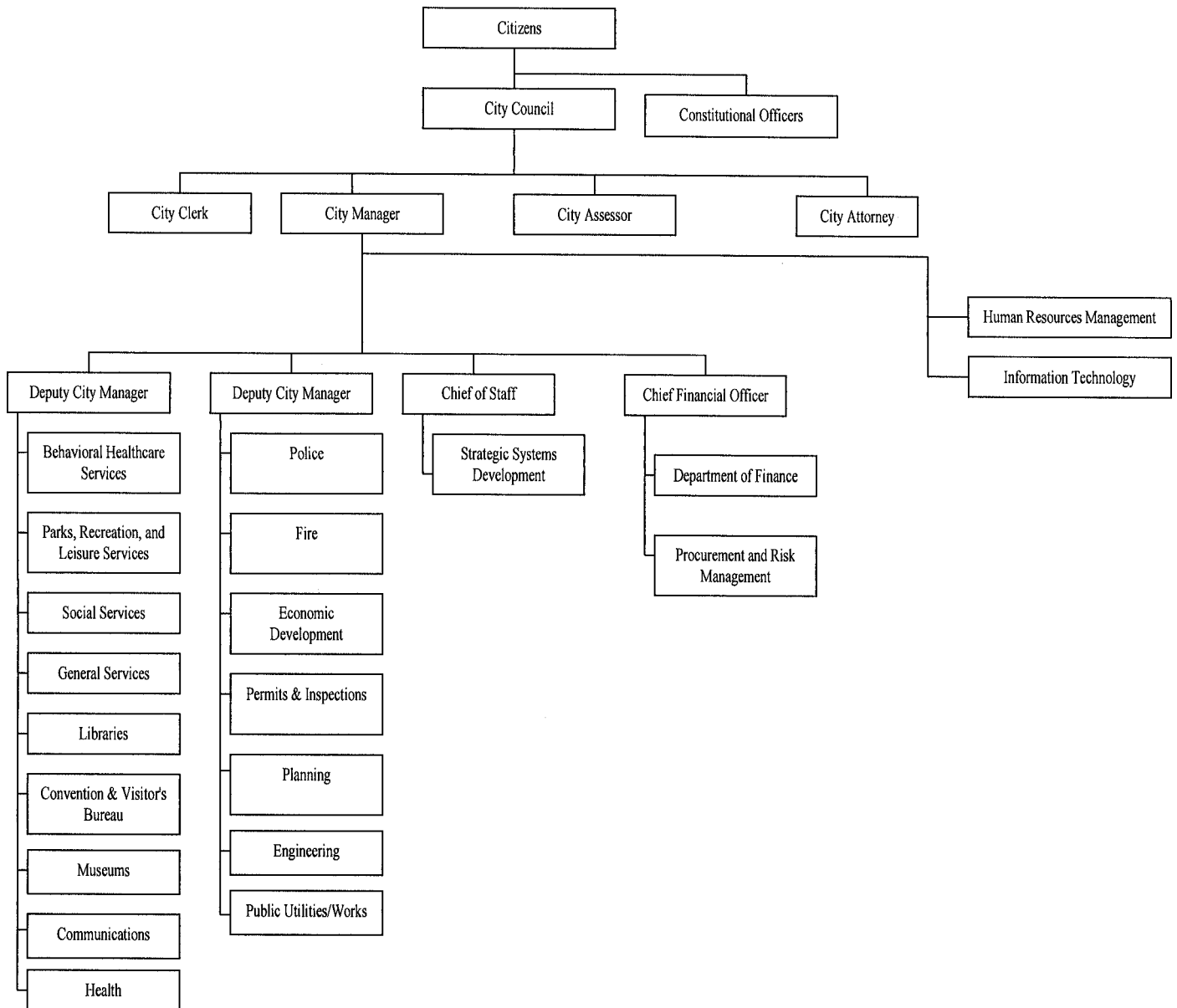
